When choosing educational methods, it is appropriate to choose based on the didactic task of each lesson. It is useful for students to practice with the "Cluster" method.


Task 1. "CLUSTER" METHOD. The cluster method is a specific form of pedagogical strategy that allows students to think freely and openly about an optional topic. The cluster method is used in connection with the working principle of the human brain. The goal is to

ensure that students' thinking activities are in harmony until they have a deep and thorough mastery of the topic. Students work individually or in groups.

Students write the names beginning with the letters "dol, zol, re, ze, je" in the table and divide it into branches.

A keyword is written in the middle, and other related terms or words are written in the branches. They, in turn, can be divided into networks.

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





Task 5. "III" METHOD. In the practical lesson on the topic "Letters Dol, Zol, Re, Ze, Je" - after the announcement of the plan on the specified topic, it is appropriate if it is used by both the teacher and the student. First of all, the purpose of using the method is determined. Purpose: To control pupils and students. Determining the level of knowledge students have on the subject being taught in the training, being able to freely express their knowledge independently, being able to evaluate their own knowledge level, being able to work individually and in groups, and determining

what else they are interested in learning. as well as teaching to systematize their knowledge.

This method can be used in all practical training classes. Through the BBB method (—I know, —I want to know, —I found out), the student can monitor himself, and the teacher can evaluate the lesson. At the beginning of the lesson, the student writes down what he knows about the subject (B1) and what he wants to know more about (B2). At the end of the lesson, he writes down what he learned (B3). Based on this, the level of knowledge of students will be determined.
