special emphasis on moral and spiritual importance, on the performance of dramatists on the stage of the theater, and on the skills of the actors.

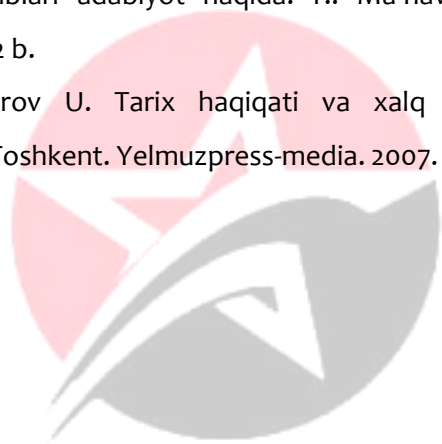
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
