The noble principles of the great ancestor of the Uzbek people, which underlie the construction of a powerful state, a just society, strengthening the atmosphere of generosity and kindness, ensuring the well-being of the population, have today become the main criterion for the socio-economic life of modern Uzbekistan.

At the initiative of President Islam Karimov, in 1996 the 660th anniversary of Amir Temur was widely

celebrated. This year in the country was named after him. International conferences and exhibitions were organized under the auspices of UNESCO. Monuments to Sahibkiran were erected in Tashkent, Samarkand and Shakhrisabz. In Uzbekistan, many streets, parks and other geographical features bear his name. The Code of Temur was restored and republished several times as a unique source for studying the history of national statehood. On the eve of the 675th anniversary of Sahibkiran, an updated edition of this book was published with a preface by the head of Uzbekistan.

Along with this, the State Museum of the History of the Temurids was opened in the capital Tashkent, which is an inexhaustible storehouse of spirituality, the keeper of ancient relics and true masterpieces of art of great historical value. Its funds contain unique items, including handwritten books, letters, coins, ceramic, bronze and copper products, decor samples, manuscripts, ethnographic items, silver jewelry and many others. During the existence of the museum, numerous exhibitions dedicated to the era of the Temurids were held. Among them are such significant expositions as "Samarkand-2750", "Gifts", "Amir Temur's Life Path", "Renaissance of the Temurids", "Shohruxhia - a monument to the creative activity of the Temurids". They tell about various aspects of the multifaceted and creative activity of the great statesman, which can serve as a vivid illustration for the moral education of the younger generation in the spirit of independence, the awakening of national self-consciousness, the study of the rich traditions of the people, ancient values, respectful and careful attitude to the invaluable heritage of ancestors. Particularly noteworthy is the fact that the order is named after Amir Temur, symbolizing for his descendants independence and justice, national pride and selfless devotion to the Motherland. He took a special place

among the high state awards established in Uzbekistan during the years of independence. For great merits in strengthening statehood, developing military affairs, they are awarded to citizens of Uzbekistan, as well as persons who are not citizens of the country, but who have made a great contribution to strengthening interstate cooperation, peace and friendship between peoples.
