

- a system of knowledge on the methods of diagnosing the capabilities of the members of the military group and the team as a whole, analyzing the received data and implementing corrective actions.

Activity and practice component. The structural part includes the ability to plan, predict, organize, implement and analyze the process of pedagogical support; to have pedagogical support technology for subordinates; abilities to encourage group activity and to form a military team as the main environment for adapting students.
